SATURDAY 26<sup>th</sup> October 2019

Drop off to be made via Howard Road Main Gate

**JUDGING:** Judging to commence 9.30 am  
on SATURDAY 26<sup>th</sup> October 2019  
Exhibition after judging completed.

**EXHIBITION:** A substantial Exhibition will be on display on Thursday and Friday of Show Week for the Public.

**LOCATION:** The Show will be held at the Cavy Show Pavilion opposite the Administration Building.

### RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Cavies must be pure bred and will be judged in accordance with the standards and general Show Regulations as provided by the ANCC.
- 2) One Cavy per handler.
- 3) Placings will be awarded at the Judge's discretion. The Judges decision is final and no discussion will be entered into at the table.
- 4) Cavies should not be removed from the Pavilion before 4.00 p.m.
- 5) Exhibitors are responsible for the supervision of their Cavies during the show. Cavies must be penned in suitable secure carry cages.
- 6) Sick or lice infested Cavies will be removed from the Pavilion.
- 7) The Judge, or immediate family of the judge or a member of the Judges household, or person or people in partnership with the Judge, may not show their Cavies at the Show at which he/she is judging.

- 8) No talking at the show table except by the judge or Steward.
- 9) No one to go behind the Judging table while judging is in progress.
- 10) All Cavies, apart from longhairs, must be shown on carpet squares approx. 30cm x 30cm or show boards 30cm x 20cm to be no higher than 5cm. Longhair Cavies can be shown on a cushion/board suitable for their breed.
- 11) The Judge may order any person from the competition for bad conduct.
- 12) Cavies purchased from the Judge, cannot be exhibited under the Judge, until the expiration of 3 months, from the date of purchase.
- 13) All Cavies exhibited at a Show must be entire (not be de-sexed). Any Cavy found not to be entire will be disqualified.
- 14) Entries will be accepted from financial members of clubs affiliated with the ANCC.
- 15) No person shall give the judge any indication as to the ownership of an exhibit not already placed in all of the classes for which it is entered and no attempt be made in any way to influence his /her awards.
- 16) **NO SUBSTITUTE ANIMALS WILL BE PERMITTED.**
- 17) In addition to any special regulations herein all Exhibitors in this section are subject to the General Regulations for Competitors and Exhibitors of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania, copies of which are available on request from the Society.
- 18) Babies age to be as at day of Show.
- 19) **"All Royal Hobart Show entrants are bound by all policies, procedures, rules and regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania. These may be amended at the discretion of the Board and the Chief Executive Officer of RAST."**

The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania advise that participation (including passive participation) in animal handling at an agricultural show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

1. By signing this waiver I acknowledge that:
  - 1.1 participation in animal handling is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the **Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010**, and also a recreational activity for the purposes of Section 19 of the **Civil Liability Act (2002) TAS**;
  - 1.2 participation in animal handling is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
  - 1.3 participation in animal handling requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
  - 1.4 animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
  - 1.5 animal showing events will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals;
  - 1.6 if the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
  - 1.7 insects or other animals may cause animals to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
  - 1.8 there is inherent in events involving the handling of animals the risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by animals; and
  - 1.9 I use the facilities supplied for the event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
- 2 If I suffer injury, loss or damage (**Loss**) while participating in an animal handling event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any Loss I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided and/or activity I have participated in.

- 3 I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the event and associated activities is dangerous and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur. I acknowledge that the event and associated activities carry with them a significant risk of physical harm. I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in regard to their negligence, breach of statutory duty or statutory guarantees arising from or in connection with these activities to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 4 At the time of participating in the event, I have not been to any degree under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
- 5 I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the Event and agree that such use may result in my being excluded from the Event or other events with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
- 6 I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania as varied from time to time.
