# SHOW REGULATIONS

## **CLOSE OF ENTRIES 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019**

- Entries in the Beef Cattle competition must be received at the RAST's Administration Office, located at Hobart Show Grounds, 2 Howard Road Glenorchy 7010 by no later than 5.00pm on the nominated entry close date. All fees must accompany entries, along with the cattle health statement forms and waiver forms. These forms can also be found on the RAST website.
- The onus is entirely on the Exhibitor to submit particulars on time.

## **SUBSTITUTIONS**

- Exhibitors will have the option of substitute entries, substitutions can only be made in the same class, no new entries will be excepted. If an exhibitor wishes to exhibit a substitute animal in lieu of the original nomination, advice must be made using the Substitution Form and must be in the hands of RAST ***no later than 5.00pm on the first Friday of October.*** This form can be obtained from the RAST Office or from their Website.

## **TRUCK & VEHICLE PARKING**

- Parking for Trucks and floats/trailers will be available along spur line, parking is limited and there must be a 5 metre road clearance for emergency vehicles. Parking tickets must be displayed at all times on vehicles whilst on ground with relevant viewable contact details.
- Parking permits will be allocated according to entries and no further permits will be issued so please do not ask.
- There will be parking available across from the showgrounds on the Brooker and pedestrian access to the show grounds can be gained through Brooker Gates.

## **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS**

- All exhibitors are to comply with the nominated arrival and departure times, priority will be given to Exhibitors that have the furthest to travel and a departure timetable will be displayed on exhibitor message board in beef cattle pavilion.
- All stock must be penned by Tuesday night of show week and can arrive as early as Saturday if wish to but must contact Chief Steward if you will be arriving prior to Monday of show week.
- No vehicles are permitted down main drive, all exhibits and exhibitors vehicle access through spurline only.

**KNOLL STREET GATE WILL BE CLOSED AT ALL TIMES. ACCESS WILL BE LEFT HAND SIDE OF MAIN GATE ALONG STOCKROUTE.**

## **ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITS**

- All females over two years of age entered must be either "in Milk" or "in calf". RAST may demand production of a Veterinary certificate that a female has been pregnancy tested "in calf", failing which RAST has the right to arrange a veterinary inspection on the Showgrounds at the expense of the Exhibitor.
- A bull or heifer entered in any class for an Exhibit of an age under 18 months shall be ineligible for exhibition in any such class if at the time of inspection of the Exhibit the bull or heifer has or shows, in the opinion of the Chief Steward or their nominee, evidence of having had a permanent tooth; or if entered in any class for and Exhibit of an age under 24 months the bull or heifer has, or shows evidence of having had more than two permanent teeth. A tooth which has erupted from the gum in whole or part shall be deemed to be a permanent tooth.
- An animal shall not be admitted to the Showgrounds unless it is entered for exhibition, with the exception of a calf at foot, as defined in these regulations.

## **CALVES AT FOOT**

- A calf of an Exhibit may be admitted if born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> March of the present year and is being suckled by the Exhibit. Such a calf is to be the natural born progeny of the Exhibit and be eligible for full registration in the Herd Book in which its dam is registered.
- All calf details must be included on the entry form, with their name, dob & sex. Exhibitors to also supply a breed card for the calf with relevant details on.
- All calves must have access to their mothers at all times.

## **STANDARD OF EXHIBITS AND INSPECTIONS**

- The standard of Exhibits shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations pertaining to the Breed Standards as accepted by the relevant Breed Society or Association and as approved by RAST.
- Any Exhibit, which in the opinion of the Chief Steward or Honorary Vet to be unfit or of ill health, shall not be eligible to exhibit and be removed from public viewing and housed in a quarantine area.
- Exhibits needing the care of the Honorary Vet or any other vet will be at the expense of the Exhibitor.
- Any animal found infected with ringworm prior to arriving at the Showgrounds must be accompanied by a veterinary certificate stating that the veterinarian has seen the animal treated in the last four days with an appropriate fungicide. If the infection is deemed to be so bad and/or unsightly that the showing of that animal is likely to detract from the spectacle of the Show, the animal may be deemed ineligible for competition at the discretion of the RAST Beef Cattle Committee.
- Any animal infected with warts should generally have them removed prior to arriving at the Showgrounds. If the infection is deemed to be so bad and/or unsightly that the show of that animal is likely to detract from the spectacle of the Show, the animal may be deemed ineligible for competition at the discretion of the RAST Beef Cattle Committee.

## **TINTING AND/OR COLOURING OF COAT**

- Should RAST, the Chief Steward or an appointed Inspector, be of the opinion that the coat of any Exhibit has been tinted and/or coloured in any way, then such an animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show.

**LEADING OF BULLS** Only persons of the age of 18 years and over are permitted to lead bulls. No bulls will be allowed in the Young Paraders

## **JOHNE'S DISEASE**

- Unrestricted entry, all Exhibitors are required to complete the NCHD (Version 26/10/16) and submit this with entries.
- All exhibitors must provide a correct Johne's Beef Assurance Score (J-BAS) with their entries.
- Exhibits will be stalled based on the J-BAS provided.
- Exhibitors need to provide proof with entry if their J-BAS score is greater than 6.

## **ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION**

- All Exhibitors must comply with the Property Identification Code and National Livestock Identification Scheme legislation of Tasmania and must provide the Property Identification Code (PIC) for the property/properties where the cattle originate from on their entry form/s. Exhibits not appropriately identified by means of an electronic identification will be deemed ineligible.
- All Exhibits must be available to have their NLIS tags scanned.
- All Exhibits including calves to have breed cards displayed in stalls, and be readily readable by public.

## **REGISTRATION**

- All Exhibits must be entered in the name of the owner(s) shown on the registration certificate.
- All animals entered must be registered in accordance with their breed.

## **NECK NUMBERS/BREAST PLATES**

- Neck numbers corresponding to the Exhibit numbers in the catalogue must be worn by the Exhibitor when entering the ring to appear before the Judge, this includes Interbreed Classes.
- Numbers can either be worn on the handlers left hip pocket (clips provided with numbers) or around animal's neck so they can be readily seen by spectators and stewards, so the animal can readily identified by the number assigned.
- All numbers and clips to be returned at end of show and can be placed in box provided in kitchen room.

## **BEDDING**

- Straw will be the bedding for the Beef Cattle shed and is included in your entry cost.
- Beddings to be cleaned out by 7:30am every morning and isles to be kept clear for the movement of the tractor. All other times must be wheel barrowed out to manure pile.
- No other rubbish such as string or general waste to be put in the straw pile.
- Cattle must be kept clean and tidy at all times, a sufficient amount of bedding must be under cattle for their comfort. Over use of Straw will not be tolerated, warnings will be issued but if continual abuse of this ruling will result in a fine.

## **PROVISION OF EXHIBITION SPACE**

- There will be no storage space for gear and feed among cattle, all feed to be stored in lower part of shed, an allocated allotment will be put aside for each exhibitor and named these areas are to be kept neat and tidy at all times.
- No blowing of cattle, clipping or any electrical leads to be used in and around cattle Stalls

## **CLIPPING FRAMES :**

- Provision for clipping frames will be allotted to exhibitors but you must state if clipping frame area is needed on entry form. This area is also to be kept neat and tidy and electrical cords etc to be packed away after use.

## **SECURITY OF ANIMALS**

- All male Exhibits born prior to 1<sup>st</sup> October of the previous year shall be rung through the nose and, at all times, shall be led by such ring. If the stewards or RAST officials determine that any bull is unsafe such bull shall be placed under such control as is directed by the Stewards or RAST officials.
- All female Exhibits must be provided with effective halters and be thoroughly broken to lead. All female exhibits must be fitted with a nose grip/dog when being led.
- All Calves must be securely tethered at all times.
- Each Exhibitor shall ensure that each of their Exhibits is securely tethered in its stall. All Exhibitors must provide neck straps or neck ropes, as well as halters for tethering their cattle and are required to tether left and right, and when not stalled, shall ensure that Exhibits are not left unattended.
- Neck chains are allowable, provided they are attached to the stall fixture by a rope. It is imperative that animals are not tethered directly to the stall fixture by means of chain and shackles.
- If in its absolute discretion RAST determines any Exhibit or Exhibits of stock to be dangerous for any reason whatsoever, RAST may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal or animals concerned to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor upon receipt of such notice shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by the Exhibitor within the time prescribed by RAST, RAST may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to RAST.

## **WEIGHING OF CATTLE**

- All bulls, irrespective of age, shall be weighed prior to judging on Tuesday at 4pm. Any bull not weighed will be ineligible for exhibition. Any other cattle can be weighed after all bulls and steers are weighed time permitting.

## **GRAND PARADE**

- All Exhibitors of ribbon winning Exhibits, including Junior, Senior and Grand Champion Exhibits must participate in the Grand Parade which will be on Thursday approximately 2:30pm. Supreme Exhibit will be presented with their ribbon by an honorary guest at the Grand Parade. No ribbons will be permitted on Exhibits except those won during the Royal Hobart Show of the current year.
- All Exhibits in the Grand Parade must wear suitable halters and nose dog/ring and be led by suitably experienced persons wearing clean and tidy cloths and suitable foot wear.

## **BEHAVIOUR AND DRESS**

- To keep harmony in the shed any bad behaviour, disrespect of other exhibitors or bad language will not be tolerated, anyone experiencing this or witness this please report to the chief steward or available committee members.
- Appropriate foot wear must be worn at all times when in and around the cattle, no thongs, boots shoes or similar aloud in shed when handling cattle.

## **SALES AND NOTICES**

- Exhibitors are permitted to display cards over the stalls stating that an animal is for sale provided such cards do not exceed 30cm x 25cm in size. No other advertisements or notices (except by permission of RAST) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings.

## **STUD IDENTIFICATION NOTICE**

- Each Exhibitor is permitted to display sign provided that such sign carries only the stud name, address, telephone number, facsimile number, e-mail address and website address.

## **JUDGING**

- Exhibits shall be present at the appropriate judging ring and ready to enter the judging ring at the time specified in the Timetable for the event to take place. Exhibits shall enter the judging ring immediately upon request by the appropriate Steward.
- Persons in charge of Exhibits must in no circumstances leave their Exhibits unattended at or in the judging ring.
- All attendants leading stock in the judging ring shall wear uniform dust coats or approved breed uniform. Such dust coat or uniform must in no way show any insignia or any descriptive markings indicating the Exhibitor's name and/or stud name or prefix.

## **FIRE AND ELECTRICAL SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- Smoking is at all times prohibited in the pavilions.
- All electrical appliances and leads must carry a current safety tag. Any electrical appliance or lead without the appropriate tag will be confiscated by an RAST official.
- An online safety induction must be completed by all participants, handlers and grooms, this can be done on our website – <http://hobartlauncestonshows.induction.integralcs.com> , cards must be carried at all times.
- No burners or open flame appliances allowed in the shed.

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- All Exhibitors when signing of entry form, you are agreeing to abide by all rules and regulations, the RAST condition of entry to Hobart Show Grounds can be found on RAST Website or by contacting the RAST office for a copy.
- All Exhibitors and their handlers, all Young Paraders and Young Judges must sign a waiver form. If under the age of 18yrs forms must be signed by parent/guardian. These forms can be submitted with your entry or passed to chief steward.

## **PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY**

- All prize money will be allocated in the means of vouchers these can either be redeemed at the bar where you will receive a further 10% on drinks or can be cashed in at the admin office the vouchers must be presented to the show office by Saturday 3:00pm or money will be forfeited.
- Prizes 1<sup>st</sup> place \$20, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$10, all other prize money is stated in trophies and special awards.

## **PRIZE RIBBONS**

- Ribbons may be awarded throughout the beef cattle classes for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places only. Sashes will be awarded to champions and reserve and interbreed winners and place getters. Rosettes will be issued to grand champion animals.
- Any unwanted ribbons can be placed at the end of show in box allocated in kitchen room.

## **YOUNG PARADERS & YOUNG JUDGES**

- Competitors are to complete the separate entry form for Young Paraders and Young Judges.
- Competitors under the age of 18 years of age are to be accompanied by a chaperone.
- All Young Paraders and Young Judge competitors must complete a waiver form, forms must be signed by parent/guardian, these forms can be obtained from the RAST website or from the show office. Completed waiver forms can be sent to RAST office by closing date of entries or handed to steward upon entering your name for classes. NO WAIVER NO ENTRY.
- No Bulls of any age are to be used in Young Paraders.

## **PERSONAL INFORMATION & PRIVACY**

The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania (RAST) collects personal information from exhibitors in competitions conducted by the Society. Verification of the accuracy of this data may be obtained through contact with the RAST. This information is used only for the purpose related to the conduct of the events run by the Society and is not divulged to third parties. However, entrant's names and contact details may be released to duly authorised parties in respect to matters of animal health and safety. The names of exhibitors may be included in catalogues published by the Society and successful exhibitors' names released for general publication. If you do not provide the information requested on the competition entry form, we may not be able to accept your entry.

# NATIONAL CATTLE HEALTH DECLARATION EXPLANATORY NOTES

## OVERVIEW

**The Cattle Health Declaration is a legal document. Please complete accurately before signing.**

Cattle Health Declarations are a way for producers to provide information about the health status of the cattle they are selling. Buyers should ask vendors for a Declaration and use the information provided to determine the health risks associated with the animals offered for sale.

Some states require testing or certification additional to that outlined in this document. e.g. Johne's disease (JD) in WA. Please check the entry requirements for any interstate movements at:

The original is to be attached to the National Vendor Declaration (NVD) form accompanying the cattle, if applicable. A duplicate remains with the vendor; it is recommended the vendor retains a copy of this declaration for seven (7) years.

## QUESTION 3: PESTIVIRUS TESTING

Persistently infected animals can be detected by conducting a pestivirus antigen test. This test only needs to be conducted once in an animal's life. Cattle that test positive in most cases are persistently infected animals. Pestivirus antibody testing may be done to check the pestivirus status of the herd. Contact your veterinarian for assistance in understanding the test results.

## QUESTIONS 4 & 5 – ENZOOTIC BOVINE LEUCOSIS (EBL)

All cattle entering Tasmania must meet at least **ONE** of the following criteria:

- Cattle have been tested for EBL with the ELISA test within 42 days before shipment with negative results and evidence supplied via an attached laboratory report. If samples were pooled, no more than 10 sera or 30 milk samples were combined in each pool. Unweaned calves less than 12-weeks-of-age transported with their dam do not require testing for EBL; *OR*
- Dairy cattle from a registered dairy herd must be accredited as Monitored Negative (MN) or better, according to the national guidelines for EBL Control; *OR*
- Beef or beef-cross breeds must come from herds in Victoria, South Australia, Western Australia (*excluding the cattle tick infected area*), New South Wales (*excluding the former North Coast Livestock Health and Pest Authority District*), or Queensland (*excluding the cattle tick infected area*). The herd of origin must have been in existence for at least three (3) years with no evidence of EBL infection in the last three (3) years.

## QUESTIONS 6, 7 & 8: JOHNE'S DISEASE BEEF CATTLE

**Note: JD is a notifiable disease, so it is important to answer these questions.**

Occurrence of JD refers to clinical disease in the herd or on the property. Clinical disease is an infected animal with chronic diarrhoea and weight-loss that does not respond to treatment.

The **Johne's Beef Assurance Score (J-BAS)** is a tool developed for JD risk profiling. Details are available on the Animal Health Australia website under 'JD in cattle'. The J-BAS is an initial guide and purchasers should ask for more information about JD in the origin herd (see JD in Cattle Biosecurity Checklist on the AHA website under 'JD in cattle'). Transitional arrangements are in place until 30 June 2017. The *National Farm Biosecurity Reference Manual - Grazing Livestock Production* provides a template to use for the property biosecurity plan. All plans should include the JD in Cattle Biosecurity Plan Checklist.

**Check test** – testing of 50 adult animals in the herd (or all eligible animals in a herd if less than 50 adult animals) biased to increase the probability of detecting infection, tested by ELISA, (pooled) faecal culture or (pooled) HT-J faecal PCR.

**Sample test** - screening of the adult herd or a large representative sample of the adult herd by an approved test (ELISA, (pooled) faecal culture or (pooled) HT-J faecal PCR).

## QUESTION 10 & 11: TREATMENTS & VACCINATIONS

Provide details on any cattle treatments and vaccinations within the last six (6) months.

Some manufacturers include more than one of the categories listed in the same vaccine, known as a combination vaccine. If you use a combination vaccine, each agent(s), as appropriate, should be detailed.

For vaccinations to be current, you must have followed the manufacturer's recommendation for vaccination. Typically, young animals or first time vaccinated animals need two (2) doses, followed by annual boosters. As variations to this general rule do occur (e.g. Silirum is given once only), you must use the manufacturer's recommendations.

At the date the declaration is made, the animals must be considered protected from the diseases listed.
